- Outreach program with WIC continues to be successful with 57 attendees.

- Awarded the 2018 Outreach Mini Grant through COSAC and STLS for \$600.42 to fund the startup of a home-delivered library service for housebound community members to begin in 2019.
- Kelly began working on the 2019 Community Arts Grant through the Finger Lakes ARTS Council to fund a variety of art-themed programs through the new year. This is due at the end of October.
- Received the 2017 Annual Statistical Report from STLS. The MFL makes up 72% of all library programming in Schuyler County; for adults, young adults, and children combined.
- Meetings with Karin and the Harvest Festival Planning Committee continued to make progress.
- Jess attended B.C. Cate Meet and Greet to connect with the school, families, agencies, and handed out flyers and program information. We've been invited to be a guest for story times over the winter.
- Several visitors came in that were evacuees from North Carolina's Hurricane Florence.
- DAC Meeting was held at the library; 7 attended in person, 9 attended online.
- Students have begun to make use of the library for school assignments.
